IMPORTANT INFORMATION

CHECK-IN – Registration will begin at 6:00pm on Friday. Please use the Conference Center entrance located to the right of the main entrance of the hotel. The Registration Headquarters will be located in one of the ballrooms and will be arranged alphabetically by church name to help the process be as efficient as possible. **Please allow only one adult leader from your church to check in at registration on Friday, as this helps with the flow of traffic.**

FREE TIME – We are excited to offer you some time for your group to play outside with other groups, share some dessert, and get out some energy! On Saturday afternoon from 1:30-4:00pm, we will gather in the circle at Epworth Children's Home (2900 Millwood Ave, Columbia, SC 29205). Bring money for dessert trucks! We will also have a DJ playing music, and plenty of games set up to play!! **Enter on Sims Street for parking and look out for the signs directing you where to park.**

REVOLUTION APP – In an attempt to be connected with Revolution attendees leading up to the event, at the event, and afterwards, we will once again offer the Revolution event app using the YAPP Platform. On the app you will find the schedule for Revolution, information about our special guests, our ministry partners, pictures, and much more. **The Revolution App also allows the Revolution Design Team to send “push notifications” during the event so please be sure to download it!**

In order to download the Revolution App, simply scan the included QR code on your cell phone or search “YAPP” in the App Store or Google Play Store. There you will need to download “YAPP” onto your phone. Once you download YAPP, you can select “download an existing Yapp” and the Revolution App should be on your phone. If that doesn’t work, simply search YAPP for “REVSC” to access it.



DOORS OPEN – The Conference Center will open at 6:00 p.m. Friday evening (with extended time for registration). Please note that there is limited space in the lobby area. For all other sessions, the Lobby areas will open 30 minutes before each Gathering begins.

This designated ballroom—located just around the corner from the main auditorium—will serve as a calming, reflective environment for anyone needing a break from the crowd or sensory intensity. Inside, you'll find themed prayer stations connected to our Rev26 theme, "Seek First," along with comfortable seating and a peaceful atmosphere for rest, reflection, and renewal. A live feed of the main auditorium will also be available for participants who want to remain connected to the session while in a quieter setting.

Students who wish to use the Alternative Worship Space should receive permission from their group's adult leaders before entering. This room is designed to support those who benefit from a quieter environment and to provide a meaningful, accessible way to "Seek First" throughout the Revolution weekend.
